 - VHF/UHF (if needed)
 - Dual band HT, speaker mic, charger, extra battery
 - Alkaline battery pack & spare batteries
 - Dual band mobile radio & antenna (manual)
 - HF (if needed)
 - HF radio capable of 6-160 meters (manual)
 - Multi-band antenna
 - Spare wire/ladder line
 - Antenna tuner (if not built into radio)
 - Headset
 - Laptop (if needed for Winlink/digital/logging)
 - Spare battery

 - Electrical/Cabling

Add-ons

- **Personal Needs Kit (24 hours)**

 - Energy/protein bars

 - Items below may be substituted with RV if allowed
 - Shelter (sleeping and operating tent)
 - Sleeping bag, foam pad, pillow
 - Portable stove
 - If RV is used, generator & fuel for RV
 - Waterproof matches
 - Medication (generic & prescription)
 - Throat lozenges
 - Additional money
 - Alarm clock (crank style)
 - Eye glasses (if required)
- **Add on for Extended Deployment (72 hours)**
 - 3-day change of clothes
 - 3-day supply of water, food, snacks
 - Additional batteries
 - Additional fuel for generator(s)
 - Additional cash
- **Add on for Extended Deployment (7 days)**
 - Laundry detergent
 - Additional 4-day change of clothes
 - Additional 4-day supply of water, food, snacks
 - Additional batteries
 - Additional fuel for generator(s)
